THE FLORIDA REAL ESTATE EXAM IS DESIGNED TO ASSESS A CANDIDATE'S KNOWLEDGE OF BOTH STATE-SPECIFIC AND NATIONAL REAL ESTATE CONCEPTS. THE EXAM TYPICALLY CONSISTS OF MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTIONS THAT COVER VARIOUS TOPICS ESSENTIAL TO REAL ESTATE PRACTICE. UNDERSTANDING THE STRUCTURE OF THE EXAM IS CRUCIAL FOR EFFECTIVE PREPARATION.

EXAM FORMAT AND DURATION

THE FLORIDA REAL ESTATE EXAM CONSISTS OF 100 MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTIONS. IT IS DIVIDED INTO TWO PARTS: 45 QUESTIONS FOCUS ON NATIONAL REAL ESTATE TOPICS, WHILE 55 QUESTIONS CONCENTRATE ON FLORIDA-SPECIFIC LAWS AND PRACTICES. CANDIDATES ARE GIVEN A TOTAL OF 3.5 HOURS TO COMPLETE THE EXAM. A PASSING SCORE IS TYPICALLY 75%, MEANING CANDIDATES MUST ANSWER AT LEAST 75 QUESTIONS CORRECTLY TO PASS.
