THUNOR (THOR)

THUNOR, THE GOD OF THUNDER, REPRESENTS STRENGTH AND PROTECTION. HE IS OFTEN DEPICTED WIELDING HIS MIGHTY HAMMER, Mjölnir, WHICH HE USES TO PROTECT THE GODS AND HUMANS FROM GIANTS. THUNOR'S INFLUENCE IN OLD ENGLISH LITERATURE OFTEN HIGHLIGHTS THEMES OF HEROISM AND THE STRUGGLE AGAINST CHAOS. HE EMBODIES THE PROTECTIVE ASPECTS OF THE NATURAL WORLD, MAKING HIM A BELOVED FIGURE AMONG THE ANGLO-SAXON POPULATION.

TIW (TYR)

TIW, ASSOCIATED WITH LAW AND HEROIC GLORY, WAS REVERED FOR HIS ROLE IN WARFARE AND JUSTICE. HE IS OFTEN DEPICTED AS A ONE-HANDED GOD, HAVING SACRIFICED HIS HAND TO BIND THE WOLF FENRIR. THIS ACT SYMBOLIZES BRAVERY AND THE IMPORTANCE OF SACRIFICE FOR THE GREATER GOOD. IN OLD ENGLISH TEXTS, TIW'S QUALITIES ARE CELEBRATED IN CONTEXTS THAT EMPHASIZE HONOR AND MORAL DUTY.

DEPICTIONS OF HEATHEN GODS IN KEY TEXTS
