THESE PROGRAMS OFTEN COVER ESSENTIAL TOPICS SUCH AS ETHICS, LAW ENFORCEMENT PRACTICES, AND COMMUNITY POLICING, EQUIPPING STUDENTS WITH CRITICAL KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS.

ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION PATHS

APPLICATION PROCESS

RESEARCHING POLICE DEPARTMENTS

THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR BECOMING A POLICE OFFICER CAN VARY SIGNIFICANTLY BETWEEN DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS. PHYSICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATIONS

PHYSICAL FITNESS STANDARDS
