HISTORICAL CONTEXT OF JUST WAR THEORY

PRINCIPLES OF JUST WAR

JUS AD BELLUM

- **JUST CAUSE:** THERE MUST BE A VALID REASON FOR GOING TO WAR, TYPICALLY IN RESPONSE TO AN ACT OF AGGRESSION.

- **LEGITIMATE AUTHORITY:** ONLY DULY CONSTITUTED LEADERS OR GOVERNMENTS CAN INITIATE A WAR.
- **RIGHT INTENTION:** THE INTENTION BEHIND THE WAR MUST BE TO PROMOTE GOOD OR AVOID EVIL.
- **PROBABILITY OF SUCCESS:** THERE SHOULD BE A REASONABLE CHANCE OF SUCCESS TO JUSTIFY THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH WAR.
- **PROPORTIONALITY:** THE ANTICIPATED BENEFITS OF THE WAR MUST OUTWEIGH THE EXPECTED HARMS.
- **LAST RESORT:** WAR MUST ONLY BE INITIATED AFTER ALL NON-VIOLENT OPTIONS HAVE BEEN EXHAUSTED.

JUS IN BELLO

JUS IN BELLO GOVERNS THE CONDUCT OF PARTIES INVOLVED IN A CONFLICT. IT OUTLINES THE ETHICAL TREATMENT OF COMBATANTS AND NON-COMBATANTS DURING WARFARE. KEY PRINCIPLES INCLUDE:

- **DISCRIMINATION:** COMBATANTS MUST DISTINGUISH BETWEEN MILITARY TARGETS AND NON-COMBATANTS, AVOIDING UNNECESSARY HARM.
- **PROPORTIONALITY:** THE FORCE USED MUST BE PROPORTIONAL TO THE MILITARY ADVANTAGE GAINED.
